

#### DOGGLE RECIPIES

#### SHAR PIE

1 large sweet potato

1/8 cup honey

1 egg

1 teaspoon allspice

Cook sweet potato and peel off skin. Mix the sweet potato with the egg And honey. Set aside.

#### Crust:

1 1/2 cups white flour1/4 cup honey1/4 cup shortening3 to 4 tablespoons iced water

Combine white flour, honey and shortening until crumbly. Add iced water 1 tablespoon at a time until mixture binds together. Knead until smooth.

Roll out dough and cut 4-inch circles to form crusts in 4-inch foil Pie pans.

Pour sweet potato mixture into crusts.

Bake at 350 degrees for 30 to 40 minutes Yield: two 4-inch pies or (1) 8-inch pie

#### TUNA BI SQUITS

1 can (8 oz) tuna in oil 2 cups cornmeal 2 cups flour 3/4 cup water 2/3 cup veg. oil 1/2 tsp. salt

Mix, roll out, cut out with dog bone cutter, bake at 350 for 25-30 min, cool serve, store in airtight container in frige. YUM!
